Maj Michael J. Parrish is the Commander at the 36th Maintenance Squadron, Andersen Air Force Base Guam. Maj Parrish leads 120 assigned and up to 180 deployed active duty, reserve component and contractor personnel across eleven Air Force Specialties. He is responsible for en-route, intermediate and off-equipment maintenance in support of ISR, Strike, Fighter, Mobility, and Transient aircraft. Additionally, he oversees the readiness of Pacific Air Forces' largest Aerospace Ground Equipment War Reserve Materiel fleet as well as the planning, reception, and employment of back-shop maintenance personnel during Indo-Pacific Command exercises and operations for regional and global events.

Maj. Parrish earned his commission in 2011 as a graduate of the Reserve Officer Training Corps Detachment 002, California State University, San Bernardino. And before taking command, Maj Parrish with the squadron's Director of Operations.
