Major Brian J. Anderson is the Commander of the 36th Expeditionary Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, Andersen AFB, Guam. He exercises administrative and tactical control over the 36th Maintenance Group Staff, and provides leadership and guidance to deployed-in Aircraft Maintenance units across B-1, B-2, B-52, KC-135, F-15, F-16, F-22, and F-35 platforms. He also coordinates multi-national exercises supporting the INDOPACOM AOR through the Bomber Task Force, Theater Support Package, and foreign units, ensuring allied and agile combat-ready forces.

Major Brian Anderson graduated from Southern Illinois University, Carbondale and was commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corps in 2011. He was selected to attend Joint Undergraduate Pilot Training at Vance Air Force Base, Oklahoma where he started his career as the Executive Officer for the 71st Student Squadron prior to flying both the T-6A Texan II and T-38C Talon aircraft. Upon graduation, he was assigned to the B-52H Stratofortress and completed Initial Qualification Training with the 11th Bomb Squadron, Barksdale Air Force Base, Louisiana. He was then assigned to the 23d Bomb Squadron, Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota. He has deployed twice in support of Central Command and Indo-Pacific Command and has supported an additional five areas of responsibility during various Higher Headquarter Directed missions. He is a native of Deerfield, Illinois and is married to his wife Rebecca (Becca).



Prior to his current position, he served as the Officer in Charge, 5th Maintenance Operations Flight, Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota where he attended the Accelerated Aircraft Maintenance Officers Course at Sheppard AFB, Texas in preparation for that position in 2020.
