Chief Master Sergeant Yusef A. Saad is the Superintendent, 36th Mission Support Group, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam. As the Superintendent, he is responsible to the Commander for leading 2,200 Air Force and Navy personnel, encompassing 57 Air Force Specialty Codes, across 7 diverse squadrons in support of PACAF's largest air base. He advises the Commander on morale, welfare, and readiness issues affecting personnel and the sustainment of 2,600 facilities and 1,200 housing units across the installation. He also assists Squadron Superintendents, First Sergeants, and Commanders by providing proper insight and direction necessary to train, utilize, and develop the group's officer and enlisted force. Additionally, as the senior enlisted leader of the largest Group, Chief Saad articulates pertinent issues to wing and joint leadership, while ensuring command policies are known and understood by the total force. Chief Saad ensures personnel and resources are properly aligned to maintain a quick deployment posture, supporting a full spectrum of military operations across the Pacific Theater.

CMSgt Saad entered the Air Force in October 2001. He graduated from the Fuels Specialist Course at Sheppard Air Force Base, TX, in February 2002. He has held a variety of positions within the Fuels Specialist career field. His assignments have included bases in Korea, Italy, California, Georgia, Wake Island, Spain, Turkey and Guam. He has deployed in support of the Global War on Terrorism, Operation SOUTHER WATCH, Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, Operation IRAQI FREEDOM, Operation JUKEBOX LOTUS, and numerous other contingency operations.

Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Superintendent for the 36th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam.
