SUBJECT: COVID-19 Mitigation Measures & Enforcement

1. Effective immediately, COVID-19 mitigation measures to include social distancing will be enforced for all members of Andersen Air Force Base (AAFB) that reside both on and off base. Social distancing and other non-pharmaceutical measures such as hand washing prevent the spread of COVID-19 and have proven effective in slowing the spread. Remember that you can be contagious to others without exhibiting any signs of illness. Social distancing and disease mitigation rules include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. All individuals on AAFB property and facilities are required to wear face coverings in public settings. Face coverings are required at all times while inside 36th MDG Clinic, AAFES (BX, Shoppettes) & DeCA Commissary facilities
 - i. Those not wearing a face covering will NOT be allowed entry into 36th MDG Clinic, AAFES, DeCA or any other public facilities on AAFB
 - ii. Face coverings must be conservative in appearance and conform to Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines. Military members wearing face coverings must maintain a professional image and colors should be aligned with uniform colors (white, black, sand, tan, sage green)
 - iii. All individuals should be prepared to lower the face covering when directed by Security Forces to verify identification
- b. Maintain 6 feet of distance between yourself and others
- c. Limit travel to essential trips only, i.e. grocery shopping, gas station, post office, pharmacy visits, transit to and from work, individual outdoor exercise, etc.
- d. No gatherings with anyone outside of your immediate household, including outdoors

- e. Tarague Beach will remain open, however ensure a minimum of 6 feet between yourself and others, excluding your immediate household
 - f. Public playgrounds and playground equipment are off limits to eliminate contact spread between children
2. Commanders will implement appropriate health protection measures for each work center. Measures should include, but are not limited to: staggered shifts/work teams, teleworking, increased work center cleaning, and cloth face coverings when members cannot maintain 6 feet.
3. Military members not in compliance with this measure will be subject to Uniform Code of Military Justice action. Civilians and spouses will be subject to barment from Andersen Air Force Base and civilian prosecution.
