# LIEUTENANT COLONEL ROBERT O. BECKENHAUER

Lieutenant Colonel Robert O. Beckenhauer is the commander of the 36th Contingency Response Squadron, Pacific Air Force's dedicated contingency response Air Base Opening unit. He leads a diverse group of Airmen capable of establishing airfields in austere environments to support mobility and fighter aircraft. His mission provides the combatant commander dynamic force employment options by enhancing freedom of maneuver during conflicts or natural disasters.

A 2003 graduate of the United States Air Force Academy, Lt Col Beckenhauer completed operational assignments in the KC-135R/T and the C-37A before being selected to crossflow to the C-17A as part of AMC's Phoenix Reach Program. Following these operational tours, he graduated from the Pol/Mil Affairs Strategist program at Air Command and Staff College, and then completed a Joint tour at U.S. Central Command as the Political/Military Affairs Chief for Lebanon and then Branch Chief for the Levant, Egypt, and Iraq. Most recently he served as the Chief of Safety for the 36th Wing at Andersen AFB.

Lt Col Beckenhauer is a Command Pilot with over 3,300 hours in the C-17A, KC-135R/T, and C-37A. This includes more than 700 Instructor/Evaluator hours and 1000 in combat supporting worldwide operations for multiple commands and theatres.
