Chief Master Sergeant Michael Macneil is the Superintendent for the 36th Munitions Squadron, Andersen AFB, Guam. He provides direction for 162 Airmen assigned to 10 diverse work centers guiding maintenance and handling of the Air Force's largest conventional War Reserve Materiel munitions stockpile worth 1.7 billion dollars as well as Munitions Materiel Handling Equipment worth 831 million dollars. He is also responsible for the management of a 5,500-acre Munitions Storage Area consisting of 155 facilities valued at 224 million dollars.

Chief Master Sergeant Macneil is from Palm Desert, California and entered the Air Force in January 1999. He completed his technical training as a Munitions Systems specialist at Shepard AFB, Texas in April 1999. His background includes various duties in the Munitions career field and three years as a diamond wearing First Sergeant. He has deployed to Saudi Arabia, Iraq, and Qatar in support of Operations SOUTHEWATCH, IRAQI FREEDOM, and INHERENT RESOLVE.
