SUBJECT: COVID-19 Mitigation Measures & Enforcement – Supplemental Policy

1. Due to a rapid increase in COVID-19 cases on and off installation and greater demand on the healthcare system, the following COVID-19 mitigation measures are effective immediately through 29 Aug 20. These measures are intended to control the length of the spike, protect critical missions, and keep members and families safe--while still considering mental health, social development and our most important quality of life activities and programs.

a. All personnel must maintain vigilance regarding physical distancing, mask wearing, and hand hygiene. Physical distancing is defined as greater than six feet between yourself and others. Personnel must continue to self-monitor for COVID-19 signs and symptoms and must inform the 36 MDG and their chain of command if they suspect they are infected, or have had close contact with a person suspected to be infected. Close contact is defined as less than six feet between yourself and another person for more than 15 minutes.

b. Limit off-installation activity to essential travel only (to/from residence or for essential functions/supplies only).

c. Delay start of in-resident DoDEA schools and associated Child and Youth Services for two weeks.

d. Limit gatherings to groups no larger than eight persons.

e. Continue to wear required masks indoors and outdoors (regardless of physical distancing) at all gatherings and in all shared workstations.

f. Commanders should identify mission-essential personnel and will maximize teleworking opportunities, especially for high-risk personnel or those that reside with high-risk individuals.

g. Do not conduct group fitness.

h. Mission-essential personnel and their families continue to avoid Defense Commissary Agency and Army and Air Force Exchange Service facilities on Saturday and Sunday.

2. Unit Commanders may be more restrictive in the interest of mitigating risk to mission and personnel.

3. Military members not in compliance with these measures may be subject to UCMJ action. Civilians and dependents not in compliance may be subject to barment from Andersen Air Force Base and civilian prosecution.

4. This memo temporarily supersedes Reference (a) until 29 Aug 20.
