COLONEL JAMES M. HENDRICKSON

Colonel Hendrickson arrived in July 2023 and currently serves as the Commander, 36th Maintenance Group, Andersen Air Force Base, GU. As commander, he is directly responsible for overseeing all aircraft maintenance and munitions support for the 36th Wing. He directs the activities of three permanent and multiple deployed squadrons, and he ensures the 36th Maintenance Group provides a full range of aircraft and munitions maintenance support for contingency, exercise, and peacetime missions operating out of Andersen AFB to meet US Pacific Command objectives. He also ensures the effective and safe operation of the largest war reserve materiel munitions stockpile in the US Air Force.

Colonel Hendrickson was commissioned into the Air Force from the University of Delaware Air Force ROTC as a 2d Lieutenant in May of 2000. He held assignments in the 91st Maintenance Squadron at Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota, the 3d Space Launch Squadron at Cape Canaveral SFS, FL, Air Force ROTC Detachment 915 at West Virginia University, the 576th Flight Test Squadron and Vandenberg AFB, CA, and command of the 36th Munitions Squadron at Guam and the 2d Munitions Squadron at Barksdale AFB, before being assigned to Air Staff.
