COLONEL JOSEPH L. SHEFFIELD

Colonel Joseph L. Sheffield is Commander of the 36th Operations Group, 36th Wing, Anderson Air Force Base, Guam. The Group is comprised of two permanent units and multiple F-15, F-16, F-22, B-1B, B-2A, and B-52H expeditionary squadrons executing Pacific Command's Theater Security Package, Continuous Bomber Presence, and peacetime and combat operations in the Indo Pacific Region. The Group executes a 24 hour, 7 days a week operation at the most forward sovereign U.S. Air Force Base in the Indo Pacific and provides the deployment, employment, and integration of air and space forces in support of U.S. and allied interests.

Colonel Sheffield received his commission from the United States Air Force Academy. He has served in a variety of operational assignments including B-1 Instructor Pilot, Evaluator Pilot,



Weapons Officer, 34th Bomb Squadron Director of Operations, 37th Bomb Squadron Commander, and 28th Operations Group Deputy Commander. He commanded the 37th Expeditionary Bomb Squadron on two deployments to Southwest Asia. His staff assignments include Chief of Future Operations and Executive Officer at 17th Air Force/Air Forces Africa. Prior to his current assignment, he served on the Joint Chiefs of Staff in the Operations Directorate as the Global Force Management Rotational Branch Chief and Division Chief of the National Military Command System Operations.

Colonel Sheffield is a graduate of Air Command and Staff College, the School of Advanced Air and Space Studies, and the Eisenhower School of National Security and Resource Strategy. He is a Command Pilot with more than 3,500 flight hours and 1,100 combat hours.

Colonel Sheffield is married to the former Sarah Doxey. They have six children.
