Lt Col Christopher Dupuis is the Deputy Commander, 36th Maintenance Group, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam. In this role, he assists the commander with overseeing all aircraft maintenance and munitions support for the 36th Wing. He directs the activities of three permanent and deployed squadrons, and ensures the 36th Maintenance Group provides a full range of aircraft and munitions maintenance support for contingency, exercise, and peacetime missions operating out of Andersen AFB to meet US Indo-Pacific Command objectives. He also ensures the effective and safe operation of the largest munitions stockpile in the US Air Force. Prior to assuming his current position, he was the Commander, 2nd Logistics Readiness Squadron, Barksdale AFB, Louisiana.

Lt Col Dupuis received his commission in 2005 from the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Auburn University. During his career, he has served in various logistics positions at the squadron and major command levels. He has deployed in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM providing logistics expertise to the 82d and 101st Army Airborne Divisions and the 45th Sustainment Brigade. He has also served in various staff positions on the HQ PACAF Staff, the Director of Logistics for Joint Task Force-Bravo, and as the Logistics Readiness Division Chief for HQ AFCENT Forward during Operations INHERENT RESOLVE and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. His responsibilities have included campaign logistics support for the Department of Defense, Justice and State forces in his previous assigned areas of responsibilities.
