Lt Colonel Jeffrey D. Schmidt is the commander of the 36th Contingency Response Squadron, Pacific Air Force's only specialized Air Base Opening force. He leads a multi-AFSC unit capable of establishing and operating airfields in austere environments in support of mobility and combat air forces operations. His unit provides the combatant commander dynamic force employment options by enhancing freedom of maneuver during conflicts or humanitarian assistance and disaster relief missions.

Lt Col Schmidt graduated from the United States Air Force Academy and commissioned into the Air Force in 2008. Upon graduation, he attended specialized undergraduate pilot training at Vance Air Force Base (AFB), Texas and Corpus Christi Naval Air Station (NAS), Texas.
