MSgt David K. Wagstaff is the First Sergeant, 36th Contingency Response Group, 36th Wing, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam. He is the principle advisor to the Commander on the health, welfare, and human resource issues of 142 military personnel across 44 Air Force Specialty Codes. MSgt Wagstaff assures the readiness of PACAF joint first response teams for diverse air mobility and combat missions to include contingency, humanitarian aid, disaster relief, POTUS support, and homeland defense operations. These response teams provide air base opening, air advising, and security forces. In addition, he is the First Sergeant for PACAF's only Regional Training Center providing combat and contingency training for all PACAF, sister services, and partner nation forces.

MSgt Wagstaff hails from Pasadena, California and joined the Air Force in January 2004. He graduated from the Avionics Test Station Component course at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas in October 2004. He later retrained into the Airborne Mission Systems Operator career field after graduating from the Career Enlisted Aviator Center of Excellence at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas in June 2008. His assignments include bases in New Mexico, Arizona, and Maryland. He has also deployed in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, UNIFIED PROTECTOR, and INHERENT RESOLVE.

Prior to his current position, MSgt Wagstaff was the Superintendent, Operations Group Tactics, 89th Operations Group, Joint Base Andrews, Md.
