Maj Marisol Vierra is the Commander of the 36th Munitions Squadron, Andersen Air Force Base (AFB), Guam. She leads 150 commissioned officers, enlisted Airmen, and government civilians in preparing to execute the U.S. Indo-Pacific Command's pacing OPLAN. The 36th Munitions Squadron stores, inspects, maintains, delivers, and accounts for the largest munitions stockpile in the Air Force, valued in excess of \$1.6 billion. She oversees all explosive operations within and the security of two Munitions Storage Areas, combined spanning 4,400 acres and encompassing 143 storage facilities and 7 operating locations.

Major Vierra earned her commission from The Ohio State University in May 2013. She served as a space operator before opting to become a missile and munitions maintenance officer in August 2014. After graduating maintenance officer training, she served in a variety of leadership positions within the Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) and conventional and nuclear munitions maintenance communities, obtaining the coveted trifecta for her career field. Prior to this assignment, Major Vierra was the Director of Operations for the 86th Munitions Squadron at Ramstein Air Base (AB), Germany.
