Senior Master Sergeant Brandon Morales serves as Senior Enlisted Leader, for the 36th Communications Squadron at Andersen AFB, Guam. In this capacity, he leads a 138-member military and civilian team, directing the wing's Cybersecurity, Network Infrastructure, Project Management and Knowledge Management portfolios for 8K joint personnel across 18 squadrons, and 12 tenant units. He also manages a portfolio of communication projects totaling \$429M, posturing execution of USINDOPACOM's Bomber and Tanker Task Force missions and 25 annual theater readiness exercises. SMSgt Morales also guides the execution of a \$2.3M budget for base-wide cyber initiatives.

Prior to his assignment at Andersen AFB, SMSgt Morales served as the Cyber Operations Flight Chief for the 96th Communications Squadron, where he led 244 personnel to execute Information Technology operations for the USAF's largest installation.



SMSgt Morales graduated from Trident Technical Community College and enlisted in 2010. He has served in deployed environments in support of OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE and OPERATION FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. He has spent his military career supporting Air Control Squadron systems, Network Operations, Defensive Cyber Operations, Mission Defense Activities, Project Management, Cybersecurity, and has served as the Primary Communicator for the Deputy Commander, U.S. Central Command.
