Senior Master Sergeant Bill "Indy" Indalecio is the Senior Enlisted Leader for the 36th Contingency Response Squadron (CRS), Andersen AFB, Guam. He leads a 62-member, globally deployable contingency operating force comprising joint enlisted personnel and officers from 25 diverse Air Force Specialty Codes (AFSCs). He oversees the management of a \$120 million Unit Type Code (UTC) inventory of 8,500 assets, a \$3.8 million vehicle fleet, 55 continuous training tasks, and 21 medical requirements. Sergeant Indalecio orchestrates hub-and-spoke openings, Agile Combat Employment (ACE)/POTUS support missions, and humanitarian aid/disaster relief missions with joint and Partner Nation members throughout the 110 million square mile Indo-Pacific theater.

A native of Guam, Senior Master Sergeant Indalecio enlisted in the Air Force in 2001 as a Ground Radio Operator. His career includes diverse assignments both within and outside his primary AFSC, including Commander's Enlisted Executive, Military Training Instructor, and Air Force Inspector General Cyber Inspector. He has significant tactical operations experience, deploying with the 352d Special Operations Group in direct support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM.
