Major Jamie E. Murdock is the Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, 36th Wing, Andersen AFB, Guam. As the Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, she assists the Staff Judge Advocate in providing legal services to a wing consisting of five groups, 17 squadrons, and 12,000 military and civilian personnel providing the President of the United States sovereign options to decisively employ airpower across the entire spectrum of engagement from America's premier forward operating location.

Maj Murdock received a direct commission as an Air Force judge advocate in November 2018 and entered active duty in March 2019. During law school, she competed in mock trial and mediation competitions. Her degree included an emphasis in Alternate Dispute Resolution. After law school, Maj Murdock was a Deputy District Attorney at the Humboldt County District Attorney's Office for two and a half years where she prosecuted Domestic Violence crimes.
